ESSENTIAL CRITERIA

We believe that the following requirements are fundamental to the role:

Education and Experience

- Educated to GCSE grade C or above (or equivalent) in Maths and English
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Experience in the use of IT, including e-mail and internet
- Ability to demonstrate knowledge of signposting agencies
- Experience of working with vulnerable adults and Young People (18+) in a health or social care setting
- Experience of writing case notes, reports and referrals
- Self-motivated and able to work independently and also as part of a team
- Excellent time management skills
- Awareness of issues in mental health service provision
- Experience of working with vulnerable individuals

Knowledge and Skills

- A good understanding of mental health conditions
- Understanding of the relationship between mental health and social issues and how these issues may impact on physical, mental and emotional wellbeing
- Understanding of relevant legislation and policies such as the Data Protection Act, Safeguarding and Protection of Vulnerable Adults
- Creative and flexible approach to working with individuals
- Ability to deal with stressful and difficult situations in a calm manner
- Ability to prioritise and manage workload
- Ability to involve service users and carers in all aspects of work

- Proven experience of the assessment, allocation and referral process in health care setting

- Experience of working in a multi-disciplinary team and with other agencies

- Knowledge or experience of a Safehaven service
